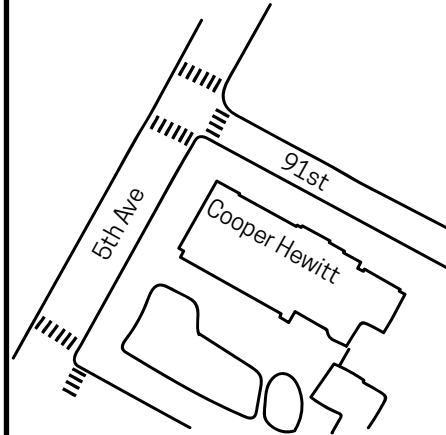


TEEN DROP IN

Know Before You Go



1. Today I will visit Cooper Hewitt Smithsonian Design Museum.



2. I will go to 2 E 91st Street between Madison and 5th Avenue.



3. I will go up the stairs or ramp located to the left of the stairs and go through the big front door.



4. I will see security guards. If I am carrying a bag, a security guard may check inside it.



5. At the top of the stairs, I will see staff with a clipboard that says, "Teen Drop In". I can tell them my name or show them my ticket.



6. I can get a fidget, earbuds, and a pair of ear defender headphones at the Visitor Experience desk.



7. Then, I will go Lecture room on the ground floor for the workshop.



8. I can take the stairs or the elevator to the ground floor, and I will take all my things with me.



9. On the ground floor I will walk to the end of the hallway to the lecture room, where another staff member will greet me.



10. While I wait for the workshop to begin, I can have a snack or drink, use the restroom, or find a seat.



11. There are rest rooms by the cafe and on the ground floor.



12. There may be other student's at my table. I can say hello or use the ice breaker card on the table.



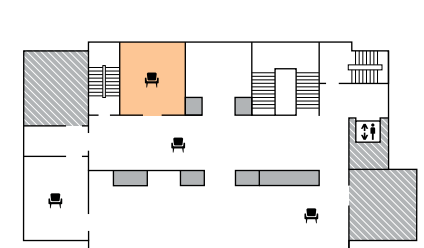
13. When the workshop begins a staff member will introduce the designer who will show us how to do the activity.



14. The activity will last about 1 hour and 15 minutes. If I need help, I can ask a staff member or the guest designer.



15. At the end of the workshop, I may share what I made, but don't have to. Then we will clean up.
