- My child will retain his or her rights to his or her submissions and, if selected as a finalist, his or her design as further developed during the competition (collectively, the "Designs"), but that the Smithsonian, Target, and those authorized by the Smithsonian, may copy, publish, distribute, publicly display, and otherwise use the Designs in whole or in part for any educational, promotional, or other standard museum purpose, in any media now known or later developed, without compensation to me or my child. This includes but is not limited to archives, educational programs, exhibitions, promotions (including on social media), research, and publications. This permission is irrevocable and perpetual. But any commercial use requires additional permissions.
- Should my child be selected for honorable mention or as a finalist, his or her first name and last name, age, and state in which he or she resides may be publicly announced on the Challenge website.
- Should my child be selected as a finalist:
  - During the week of March 7, 2016, my child may participate in a videoconference (SKYPE) conversation with a Target furniture designer who is to work with my child at the Student Design Challenge workshop.
  - I will travel with my child to New York City for the design workshop and judging on Friday April 1 through Sunday April 3. I understand that the Student Design Challenge's sponsor, Target Corporation, will provide airfare and lodging for me and my child's travel in order to make this trip, and that breakfast and lunch will be provided at the workshop, but all other expenses associated with this trip will be my sole responsibility.

- I hereby give the Smithsonian and Target permission to photograph and video and otherwise document my and my child's participation in the workshop and judging, and to use any such documentation (which may include my and/or my child's likeness, statements, name, or actions) for any educational, promotional, or standard museum purpose, in any media now known or later developed, without compensation to me or my child.
- Should my child be selected as the winner:
  - I will travel with my child to Target Corporation's headquarters in Minneapolis Minnesota to review a prototype (final sample) of their design the weekend of Friday, May 13-15, 2016. I understand that Target will provide airfare and lodging for this trip, but I will be responsible for all other expenses associated with this trip.
  - I will encourage my child to cooperate with Target's reasonable requests in connection with fabrication of any prototypes or chairs.
- The Smithsonian and Target are under no obligation to use or retain my child's Design.
   Further, although the winning design will be produced and temporarily displayed at the Smithsonian, my child's Design will not be accessioned into the Smithsonian's collections.
- I release and hold harmless the Smithsonian and its regents, agents, employees and
  volunteers, and Target Corporation, from any and all claims, actions and demands of any
  kind arising out of my child or my participation in Cooper Hewitt Student Design
  Challenge and my or my child's acceptance or usage of the prize, or the Smithsonian's or
  Target's use of my child's Design or his or her name and likeness as provided herein.
