About the awards. Launched in 2000 as an official project of the White House Millennium Council, the National Design Awards are bestowed annually in recognition of design innovation and impact.

This is the inaugural year of the Climate Action Award, which recognizes the crucial role design plays in shaping a more sustainable future, and the second year of the Emerging Designer Award.
