taking prescription medicine in Bangladesh, AmeriCares collaborated with GSK and local health organizations to train pharmacy clerks in Mymensingh. With our training, pharmacy clerks at one hospital now have the knowledge to safely dispense medicine, including providing patients with information on completing their treatment—a crucial instruction in lowresource countries where improper use of antibiotics leads to antibioticresistant infections. The pharmacy clerks are trained to pass the knowledge to others, creating a culture of safety and responsibility.
