



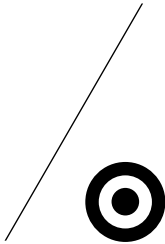
PARENT OR LEGAL GUARDIAN CONSENT

In consideration of the opportunity for my child to participate in the Cooper Hewitt, Smithsonian Design Museum ("Smithsonian") National High School Design Competition ("Design Competition"), I agree that:

- My child's participation is subject to the [Design Competition Rules and Conditions](#), which I have reviewed with him or her.
- My child will retain his or her rights to his or her submission and, if selected as a finalist, his or her design as further developed during the competition (collectively, the "Designs"), but that the Smithsonian, Target Corporation ("Target"), and those authorized by the Smithsonian, may copy, publish, distribute, publicly display, and otherwise use the Designs in whole or in part for any educational, promotional, or other standard museum purpose, in any media now known or later developed, without compensation to me or my child. This includes, but is not limited to, archives, educational programs, exhibitions, promotions (including on social media), research, and publications. This permission is irrevocable and perpetual. Any commercial use requires additional permissions.
- Should my child be selected as a finalist, his or her first name and last name, age, and state in which he or she resides may be publicly announced on the Design Competition website and promotional materials.
- Should my child be selected as a finalist:
 - During the week of April 10 or 17, 2017, my child will participate in a videoconference (SKYPE) or phone conversation with a Food + Future mentor who is to work with my child during the Mentor Day.
 - I will travel with my child to Boston for the Design Competition Mentor Day on May 13, 2017. I understand that domestic travel and lodging will be provided for me and my child in order to make this trip. All other expenses associated with this trip will be my sole responsibility.
 - I will travel with my child to New York City for the Jury Day on Sunday, June 4, 2017. I understand that domestic travel and lodging will be provided for me and my child in order to make this trip, but all other expenses associated with this trip will be my sole responsibility.
 - I will encourage my child to cooperate with the Smithsonian and Target's reasonable requests in connection with the Design Competition.
 - I hereby give the Smithsonian and Target permission to photograph and video and otherwise document my and my child's participation in the Mentor Day and the Jury Day, and to use any such documentation (which may include my and/or my child's likeness, statements, name, or actions) for any educational, promotional, or standard museum purpose, in any media now known or later developed, without compensation to me or my child.
 - My child's design will be featured on the Cooper Hewitt Design Competition website.



- Should my child be selected as the winner:
 - I will travel with my child to Target’s headquarters in Minneapolis, Minnesota during summer 2017. I understand that domestic travel and lodging will be provided for me and my child’s travel in order to make this trip, but all other expenses associated with this trip will be my sole responsibility. I understand that this trip is optional, but is highly encouraged.
 - I will travel with my child to New York City during National Design Week to attend the Teen Design Fair on October 17, 2017. I understand that domestic travel and lodging will be provided for me and my child’s travel in order to make this trip, but all other expenses associated with this trip will be my sole responsibility. I understand that this trip is optional, but is highly encouraged.
 - My child’s design will be featured at Cooper Hewitt during National Design Week (October 14–22, 2017), at the Target Fenway store in Boston, and on the Cooper Hewitt Design Competition website.
 - I will encourage my child to cooperate with the Smithsonian and Target’s reasonable requests in connection with the Design Competition.
- The Smithsonian and Target are under no obligation to use or retain my child’s Designs. Further, although the winning design will be featured at the Smithsonian, my child’s Designs will not be accessioned into the Smithsonian’s collections.
- I release and hold harmless the Smithsonian and its regents, officers, agents, employees, fellows, interns, research associates, and volunteers, and Target, from any and all claims, actions and demands of any kind arising out of my child or my participation in the Cooper Hewitt National High School Design Competition and my or my child’s acceptance or usage of the awards and prizes, or the Smithsonian or Target’s use of my child’s Designs or his or her name and likeness as provided herein.
